HFD Emergency Responders wishing to schedule their COVID-19 vaccine with Methodist Hospital will no longer be able to do so by the previously provided link, as that link has been terminated. Methodist Hospital will contact HFD members by the email provided via the survey. Methodist Hospital currently stocks Moderna and Pfizer vaccines. Recipients will not be able to choose which they receive.

HFD members can log-in to the TMS by utilizing their regular station computer credentials.

COVID vaccine scheduling links provided by any system are not to be shared or forwarded to other persons. HFD members who utilize COVID vaccine scheduling links are not to schedule other family members or friends. These vaccine opportunities are solely for the member at this time.
