Please ensure ONLY the CURRENT HFD Form 51 "Supervisors Incident Packet" located on HFD Desktop/Document Center/Forms is used to report an occupational injury, illness, or exposure. Earlier printed versions of the packet contain outdated contact information and reporting instructions and may delay processing of the claim.

Supervisors reporting a member's possible exposure to COVID-19, please utilize the following guidelines:

- For member exposures designated as "Low Risk" by Infection Control and Medical Direction -
 - Upon completion of the Supervisor's Incident Packet, check the "Record Only" box in Section 1
 - Fax the Supervisor's Incident Packet to (832)395-9470 OR email to hrwcf@houstontx.gov
- For member exposures designated as "Medium Risk" or "High Risk" by Infection Control and Medical Direction -
 - Upon completion of the Supervisor's Incident Packet, check the "Medical" box in Section 1
 - Call (832)393-7233 (SAFE) then PRESS Option 1
 - o Use the completed Incident Report to answer all questions asked by the
 - **Document** the reference # provided by the call taker in Section AC of the Incident Report
 - Fax the Supervisor's Incident Packet to (832)395-9470 OR email it to hrwcf@houstontx.gov
- A member required to self-quarantine per Infection Control and Medical Direction as a result of a "Medium Risk" or "High Risk" on-duty exposure shall be coded as WC if unable to report for work on his/her next scheduled shift and any subsequent shifts UNTIL CLEARED BY INFECTION CONTROL to return to work.
